

## Piton



Possible example of Piton D4 listed by Proud as a single example with PITON handwritten in dated 23.12.47 although apart from the illustration in Proud's book, I do not know of a actual photocopy/scan of the stamp Proud illustrates.

May have been adapted from a PORT LOUIS or other MAURITIUS cds with the words cut out, however nothing has been handwritten in these examples two of each from 29th and 30th Sep 1947 measured as 25.5mm diameter

The procedure I assume being similar to how MAHEBOURG D7 was adapted from the PILLAR BOX cds
